CONFESSION

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Our Lord Jesus Christ has told us that to enter the kingdom of heaven we must be born again of water and the Spirit, and has given us baptism as the sign and seal of this new birth. Here we are washed by the Holy Spirit and made clean. Here we are clothed with Christ, dying to sin that we may live his risen life. As children of God, we have a new dignity and God calls us to fullness of life.

At the baptism of children, the president addresses the whole congregation:

Jesus said, 'Let the children come to me. Do not stop them. For the Kingdom of God belongs to children'. We thank God for **N** who is brought to be baptized today. Christ loves *her* and welcomes *her* into his Family, the Church.

So I ask you all: Will you support this child as *she* begins *her* journey of faith? All With the help of God, we will. Will you help *her* to live and grow within God's family – the church?

With the help of God, we will.

THE PRESIDENT THEN ADDRESSES THE PARENTS AND GODPARENTS

God knows each of us by name and we are his. Parents and godparents, the church receives this child with joy. In baptism *she* begins *her* journey in faith.

You speak for *her* today.

Will you care for *her*, pray for *her*, and help *her* to follow Christ as *she* grows older?

With the help of God, we will.

THE DECISION

The minister addresses the candidates (parents and godparents) directly:

We all wander far from God and lose our way: Christ comes to find us and welcomes us home. In baptism we respond to his call.

Therefore, I ask:

Do you reject the devil and all rebellion against God?

I reject them.

Do you renounce all that is evil? **I renounce evil.**

Do you turn away from sin?

I turn from sin.

Do you trust in Christ as your Saviour?

I trust in Christ.

Do you submit to Christ as your Lord?

I submit to Christ

Will you follow Christ in your words and in your actions?

I will follow Christ.

Profession of Faith (all believers)

Brothers and sisters, I ask you to profess together with *this family* the faith of the Church. Do you believe and trust in God the Father? *All*

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ?

All

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,

who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate.

was crucified, died, and was buried;

he descended to the dead.

On the third day he rose again;

he ascended into heaven,

he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead. Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Prayer over the Water

Praise God who made heaven and earth, *All*

who keeps his promise for ever.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. *All*

It is right to give thanks and praise.

We praise you, loving Father, for the gift of your Son Jesus. He was baptized in the River Jordan, where your Spirit came upon him and revealed him as the Son you love. He sent his followers to baptize all who turn to him. In joyful obedience to your Son, we baptise into his church all those who come to Him in faith.

Now, Father, we ask you to bless this water, that those who are baptized in it, by the power of your Holy Spirit,

may be cleansed from their sins, born again, filled with your Spirit, and may know that they are loved as your children, safe in Christ for ever. **Amen**.

N, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen**.

SIGNING WITH THE CROSS

N. Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross. Do not be ashamed of Christ. You are his for ever.

Stand bravely with Christ against sin, the world and the devil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.

May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ Jesus our Lord. **Amen**.

The minister gives a lighted candle to the newly baptised:

I give you this candle as a symbol of the light of Christ.

May the light of Christ shine brightly in your life every day. Amen

May God, who has received you by baptism into his Church, pour upon you the riches of his grace, that within the company of Christ's pilgrim people you may daily be renewed by his anointing Spirit, and come to the inheritance of the saints in glory. **Amen**.


